The Department of Management Studies, MITS in collaboration with Unit Trust of India (UTI) organized a webinar on Investor Awareness and Money Management on 11th March 2022. The session timing was from 10:30a.m.-11:40a.m. The webinar was initiated by Prof. SremmantBasu, Dean Administration and International Relation and Head Department of Management Studies. The resource person Mr. Swetav Tripathy. was introduced by Dr.

Shahrukh Saleem, Assistant Professor and Program Coordinator, Department. of Management Studies. The resource person highlighted the importance of Investor awareness and Money Management to the students.

The resource person addressed the students with the various insights into Investor awareness and also elaborated at length on various ways through which Money Management can be done in a successful manner. The different ways that can benefit individuals with regards to money management in the Indian Capital market was discussed at length. The various investment avenues such as equity trading, derivatives trading, currency trading and mutual funds investment along with the risks associated with each investment avenue were highlighted by the resource person.

The session was more of an interactive session wherein the students were allowed to raise any questions during the session and also answer to the questions asked by the resource person. This helped the students enhance their knowledge in the finance domain.

Mutual fund investment was suggested by the resource person as a safe investment for the people who are unable to manage their portfolio and also want good return on their investment. Various Mutual Funds are available in the country along with expert fund managers managing the corpus of the investors. These fund managers ensure good Return on Investment (ROI) for the investors. The students were also informed about the derivatives trading being one of the risky investment options.

Equity market investment and various Initial Public Offerings (IPOs) given by the companies are considered to be the most sought-after investment avenues. The audience were informed about the ways invest in equity market and IPOs through the Demat Account with their respective Stockbroker.

Apart from the interaction during the program the program also had a Question-Answer session at the end of the session in which many students raised their queries which were answered by the resource person.
